

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND HALL RULES 2026 / U15 AND U13 JUNIORS

- Tournament mode:** The tournament is played in four groups with four teams. In the group everyone plays against everyone. The points earned and goals will be taken to the intermediate round.
- In the second round, four groups of four teams each will be formed. The respective groups get first and third, the second and fourth placed assigned to another group (Gr. A of Gr. B and vice versa, and Gr. C of Gr. D and vice versa). In the second round, only the teams play against each other, those in the preliminary round not in the same group were.
- The final round is formed from the placements of the intermediate round. From the four teams with the fewest points, the two with the fewest points again dropping out. The other two play for 13th place. In the final round, four groups of three teams each will be formed. If there is a winner in the first group match of the final round, this team sit out in the second final round match. In the event of a draw, the schedule unchanged. The top four teams advance to the semi-finals, the winners the final.
- Rules:** The tournament will be organized according to the valid guidelines of the BFV („Guidelines for indoor football“). BFV = Bavarian football association.
- Number of players:** A team consists of 4 field players, 1 goalkeeper and max. 5 substitute players.
- Change:** You must always exit and enter the field from the same place
- Playing time:** The playing time for all games is 1 x 12 minutes.
- Point and goal equality:** Lottery is not practiced but, if necessary, Nine-meter shooting was done.
- Balls:** It is played with leather ball.
- Kicking of:** The first mentioned team plays from the point of view of the tournament management from the left to the right and has kick-off.
- Bound:** It is played with all around bound.
- Referees:** The matches are conducted by certified referees.
- Indoor shoes:** The coaches of the individual teams are asked for it take care that the players only with clean shoes on participate in the tournament.
- Passport control:** The passport control is carried out before the first match.
- Conduct in the tectake Arena:** The pitch and the interior area of the tectake Arena are only accessible to participating teams, their coaches, supervisors, the tournament management, the organizing team, paramedics, and wheelchair users. The changing room corridors and dressing rooms of the tectake Arena are only accessible to participating teams (registered players), their coaches, supervisors, the tournament management, the organizing team and paramedics.
- Ball games are prohibited for all spectators and visitors in the tectake Arena, and the lower foyer is designated for all participating teams to warm up and stay (without any ball activities).

In case of non-compliance, the ORGANIZING TEAM may issue expulsions from the hall.

Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed in the tectake Arena, including bringing your own alcohol. Smoking is strictly prohibited throughout the interior of the tectake Arena (including foyer, changing rooms, toilets, etc.).

Press:

As before, photographers and journalists from the regional press may use the interior area of the tectake Arena for their journalistic work. All other photographers and journalists are kindly asked to use the public spectator areas.
